STAFF RETREAT

We had a strategic staff retreat (25th–27th February 2025). The retreat was instrumental in reviewing the organization's approved Financial and HR Policies. A major highlight was the drafting of the proposed HaLCiA Code of Conduct (Staff Handbook) which is currently under review by the Board for approval. This initiative sets the tone for a culture of

accountability and excellence within our organization.

CHURCH PARTNERSHIP UNIT ENGAGEMENTS

Training: First ECWA Church Makurdi, Benue State, Nigeria (February 23-24, 2025)

We had the privilege of facilitating a Servant Leadership training during a Sunday service and a follow-up session with agency leaders, Elders and some members the following day at First ECWA Church, Makurdi, Benue State. The sessions were highly impactful and received with great enthusiasm by the participants. One participant even asked if the training sessions were recorded, expressing that the contents of the training was so valuable so much such that it should be shared widely, because it offers solutions to the challenges currently facing both the church and the government.



JETS Engagement (March 13, 2025)

We continued to enjoy a good working relationship with Jos ECWA Theological Seminary (JETS). We engaged the current Student Union Government (SUG) and departmental leaders in a three-days training retreat in July 2024 and recently this March 2025. On the 13th of March 2025 we had the privilege of engaging the entire Admin staff and a few faculty staff of JETS in a one-day training on the principle and practice of servant leadership and the outcome was very encouraging. The impact was remarkable, reflecting a growing institutional leadership interest in servant values.



UNIVERSITY OF JOS INITIATIVE

As you know HaLCiA is fully registered with the University of Jos. This is a remarkable

achievement and it will go a long way in expanding our influence within the university community. Presently we have an Ongoing Servant Leadership Training at the university involving 40 students (organized into groups of 10) equipping them with leadership skills based on service, responsibility, and transformation.



INFRASTRUCTURE UPDATE

Property Acquisition: As you may already know, we've been working on the HaLCiA Retreat Center project, and we're excited to share that we have successfully acquired a property in Jos, Plateau State, Nigeria. This space will serve both as a retreat center and as our office headquarters, helping to reduce operational costs. All tenants previously occupying the property have been issued notices and have vacated the premises as of last month.

Renovation & Office Relocation

- The acquired property requires serious renovation to become fully operational and habitable as an office and retreat center.
- The organization plans to move into the newly acquired property by June 2025.

We intend to begin using the boys' quarters as our office space to reduce expenses, as the lease on our current office will expire by then.
