OFFICE RELOCATION

One of the major milestones this quarter was the successful relocation of the HaLCiA office from rented apartments to our own property at No. 1 Kwantagora Street, Old Lamingo Road, Angwan Rukuba, Jos North LGA. This new property will now serve as both our operational base and retreat center. It not only helps us cut down on rental costs but also provides greater capacity for ministry. In addition, two of our support staff members are currently living on the property, which has been a great help in reducing challenges related to rent and transportation for them while also helping HaLCiA to avoid

further costs of employing a security guard. We are trusting God for the resources needed to complete the renovations and make the facility fully functional for the office and also serve as the HaLCiA training centre.



ABUJA PASTORS TRAINING

In May, we held a Servant Leadership Training in Abuja with 20 pastors in attendance. The sessions were highly interactive and deeply impactful, focusing on the principles and practice of servant leadership. Feedback from participants highlighted the urgent need for this kind of training within pastoral circles.



HaLCiA & SOLCI YOUTH TRAINING.

HaLCiA partnered with the Sentinel Oasis for Love and Care Initiatives (SOLCI) program in Jos North, where around 100 youths from 20 electoral wards received training. Our session focused on the principles of servant leadership, encouraging participants to view leadership as service rather than power. The impact was remarkable, as the young leaders left inspired and empowered to positively their schools and communities.



UNIVERSITY OF JOS INITIATIVE

Our five ongoing Servant Leadership groups at the University of Jos, with about 65 students are now approaching the completion of the Servant Leadership Principles Course. The growth and transformation we have witnessed in these students are truly encouraging and we eagerly look forward to celebrating their graduation in the coming months
